SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations and Professions

- (a) An applicant for admission to the Bar shall submit to the Board a petition to the Court of Appeals on the form that the Board provides.
 - (b) An applicant shall pay to the Board:
- (1) an examination fee net exceeding [\$150] \$400, as set by the Court of Appeals, NOT EXCEEDING:
 - (I) \$250 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009; AND

 - (2) any other fee set by the Court of Appeals.

(a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this section.
