- (3) (4) A person may not use these reports for any other purpose.
- (e) A civil or criminal action may not be brought against any person who makes a report under this section and who does not violate any confidential or privileged relationship conferred by law.
- (f) A report made under this section may not be used as evidence in any civil or criminal trial, except in a legal action involving an alleged violation of a confidential or privileged relationship conferred by law.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 424

(House Bill 766)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Medical Advisory Board - Confidentiality Use of Confidential Records and Reports

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Medical Advisory Board appointed by the Motor Vehicle Administrator to disclose Motor Vehicle Administration to use, whether unilaterally or in certain collaboration, certain information of the Medical Advisory Board for certain purposes subject to a certain restriction; and generally relating to the disclosure use of information of the Medical Advisory Board by the Medical Advisory Board Motor Vehicle Administration use certain information in certain confidential reports and records for driver safety research subject to a certain restriction; authorizing the Administration to contract with third parties to assist with driver safety research; and generally relating to the use of certain confidential reports and records.
