(5) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;

(6) THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER, OR THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S DESIGNEE;

(7) A STATE'S ATTORNEY, ~~RECOMMENDED~~ DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE'S ATTORNEYS' ASSOCIATION AND WHO SUPPORTS THE DEATH PENALTY AND HAS PROSECUTED A DEATH PENALTY CASE; AND

(8) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND REFLECTING THE BROAD DIVERSITY OF VIEWS ON CAPITAL PUNISHMENT, AND THE RACIAL, ETHNIC, GENDER, AND GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF THE STATE:

(I) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHIEFS OF POLICE ASSOCIATION;

(II) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND STATE LODGE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE;

~~(H) (III) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES WHO IS ALSO EMPLOYED AS A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER IN A STATE PRISON;~~

~~(H) (IV) A FORMER STATE PRISONER WHO HAS BEEN EXONERATED OF THE CRIME FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL WAS INCARCERATED;~~

~~(IV) (V) ONE REPRESENTATIVE~~ THREE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE RELIGIOUS COMMUNITY; AND

~~(V) (VI) THREE~~ SIX REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, TO INCLUDE AT LEAST ~~ONE~~ THREE FAMILY ~~MEMBER~~ MEMBERS OF A MURDER VICTIM.

(D) THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES JOINTLY SHALL APPOINT THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION.
