- (4) ONE <u>FORMER</u> MEMBER OF THE JUDICIARY, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE OF THE COURT OF APPEALS;
- (5) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE;
- (6) THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER, OR THE STATE PUBLIC DEFENDER'S DESIGNEE;
- (7) A STATE'S ATTORNEY, RECOMMENDED DESIGNATED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE MARYLAND STATE'S ATTORNEYS' ASSOCIATION AND WHO SUPPORTS—THE—DEATH—PENALTY—AND HAS PROSECUTED A DEATH PENALTY CASE; AND
- (8) THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND REFLECTING THE BROAD DIVERSITY OF VIEWS ON CAPITAL PUNISHMENT, AND THE RACIAL, ETHNIC, GENDER, AND GEOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF THE STATE:
- (I) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND CHIEFS OF POLICE ASSOCIATION;
- (II) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE MARYLAND STATE LODGE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE;
- (II) (III) A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES WHO IS ALSO EMPLOYED AS A CORRECTIONAL OFFICER IN A STATE PRISON;
- (HI) (IV) A FORMER STATE PRISONER WHO HAS BEEN EXONERATED OF THE CRIME FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL WAS INCARCERATED;
- $\overline{\text{(IV)}}$ $\underline{\text{(V)}}$ ONE REPRESENTATIVE THREE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE RELIGIOUS COMMUNITY; AND
- (V) (VI) THREE SIX REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, TO INCLUDE AT LEAST ONE THREE FAMILY MEMBERS OF A MURDER VICTIM.
- (D) THE GOVERNOR, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES JOINTLY SHALL APPOINT THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION.
