

(1) shall submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and

(2) except as provided in § 5-308 of this subtitle, shall pay to the Board or the Board's designee the appropriate examination fee established by the Board in accordance with § 5-205 of this title in an amount not to exceed the cost of the required examination.

[(b) In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for a license to provide makeup artist services shall submit to the Board credentials that certify sufficient training.]

5-310.

(a) Subject to subsections (b) through (d) of this section and while a license to practice cosmetology is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to practice cosmetology.

(b) [While a limited license to provide makeup artist services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only makeup artist services.

(c) While a limited license to provide esthetic services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only esthetic services.

[(d)](C) While a limited license to provide nail technician services is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide only nail technician services.

5-313.

[(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each] **EACH** license issued under this subtitle shall be displayed conspicuously by the licensee in the office or place of employment of the licensee.

[(b) During hours of employment, the holder of a limited license to provide makeup artist services:

(1) shall carry the limited license; and

(2) on request, shall show the limited license.]

5-501.

(a) A person shall hold a beauty salon permit issued by the Board before the person may operate a beauty salon in the State.
