

(11) the following two faculty members of universities or colleges in the State, jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House:

(i) one member who has special expertise in government administration; and

(ii) one member who has special expertise in business management; and

(12) three representatives of organizations currently contracting with the State to provide health or social services, appointed by the Governor.

(c) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House jointly shall designate the chair of the Task Force.

(d) The Task Force may establish subcommittees as it determines necessary to fulfill its duties.

(e) ~~The Department of Budget and Management and the Department of General Services Department of Legislative Services~~ departments represented on the Task Force shall provide staff for the Task Force.

(f) A member of the Task Force:

(1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(g) The Task Force shall:

(1) evaluate and make recommendations regarding the methods used by State agencies to procure the delivery of health and social services;

(2) examine and make recommendations regarding State agencies' timeliness in preparing and issuing requests for proposals for the delivery of health and human services;

(3) examine and make recommendations regarding the timeliness of payments to contractors;

(4) examine and make recommendations regarding possible standardization of contracting processes among and within State agencies, including standardization of related documents and documentation required of contractors; and
