- (11) the following two faculty members of universities or colleges in the State, jointly appointed by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House:
- (i) one member who has special expertise in government administration; and
- (ii) one member who has special expertise in business management; and
- (12) three representatives of organizations currently contracting with the State to provide health or social services, appointed by the Governor.
- (c) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House jointly shall designate the chair of the Task Force.
- (d) The Task Force may establish subcommittees as it determines necessary to fulfill its duties.
- (e) The Department of Budget and Management and the Department of General Services Department of Legislative Services departments represented on the Task Force shall provide staff for the Task Force.
 - (f) A member of the Task Force:
 - (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but
- (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (g) The Task Force shall:
- (1) evaluate and make recommendations regarding the methods used by State agencies to procure the delivery of health and social services;
- (2) examine and make recommendations regarding State agencies' timeliness in preparing and issuing requests for proposals for the delivery of health and human services;
- (3) examine and make recommendations regarding the timeliness of payments to contractors;
- (4) examine and make recommendations regarding possible standardization of contracting processes among and within State agencies, including standardization of related documents and documentation required of contractors; and
