- (A) IF A PERSON VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF TITLE 21, SUBTITLE 4 OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE VIOLATION CONTRIBUTES TO AN ACCIDENT THAT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OR, AS DEFINED IN § 27–113 OF THIS SUBTITLE, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY OF ANOTHER, THE PERSON IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION:
- (1) THE PERSON IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$1,000; AND
- (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND THE PERSON'S LICENSE FOR NOT MORE THAN 180 DAYS.
- (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 12, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE, A LICENSEE MAY REQUEST A HEARING ON A LICENSE SUSPENSION IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  $1,\,2008.$

## **CHAPTER 444**

(Senate Bill 718)

AN ACT concerning

Lead Risk Reduction - Acquisition of Property - Compliance Requirements

FOR the purpose of authorizing a person who intends to acquire a property that is considered to be affected under certain lead risk reduction provisions to submit a compliance plan to the Department of the Environment; requiring a person who has acquired, or will acquire, an affected property to give certain notice and information at a certain time; establishing a process and a fee for submitting an application for a compliance plan; requiring the Department to approve or deny the plan, or request additional information, within a certain number of days after the plan is submitted; authorizing the Department to deny certain applications under certain circumstances; requiring either certain proof that a certain risk reduction standard has been satisfied or a certain inspection report
