

America: (xii) one representative of the Specialty Vehicle Institute of

Medical Services Systems; (xiii) one representative of the Maryland Institute for Emergency

Association; and (xiv) one representative of the Maryland State Firemen's

following regions: (xv) one representative of a Maryland ATV club from each of the

1. western Maryland;
2. southern Maryland;
3. the eastern shore of Maryland; and
4. central Maryland.

(c) From among its members, the Task Force shall select a chair of the Task Force.

(d) The Maryland Institute for Emergency Medical Services Systems shall provide staff for the Task Force.

(e) A member of the Task Force may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force.

(f) The Task Force shall identify and study major issues related to ATV safety and shall make findings and recommendations regarding:

- (1) accurate methods of tracking ATV ownership in the State;
- (2) appropriate safety equipment;
- (3) effective methods of educating consumers;
- (4) appropriate locations for ATV use;
- (5) training for ATV owners;
- (6) public awareness of ATV safety-related topics; and
