

IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE REFUND IS A RESULT OF A FAILURE TO FILE A REPORT WHEN DUE OR OTHER TAXPAYER ERROR.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008, and shall be applicable to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 2008.

(House Bill 440)

AN ACT concerning

Procurement – Service Contracts – Notice to ~~State Employees and~~ Exclusive Representatives

FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of Public Works to ensure that certain procurement regulations provide for procedures that are consistent with certain provisions of law; requiring that notice of certain rights be given to exclusive representatives of certain employees ~~and their exclusive representatives~~ at certain points in the procurement process; providing that a violation of a certain provision does not constitute grounds to challenge or appeal certain awards and processes; providing that certain notice requirements must be met for certain service contracts to be certified; ~~authorizing the Department of General Services and the Department of Budget and Management to adopt certain regulations; requiring a procurement unit in the Executive Branch of the State government to include certain information in certain required~~ altering certain notice requirements included in certain plans of assistance for certain State employees who will be adversely affected by certain service contracts; defining ~~certain terms a certain term~~; and generally relating to notice requirements for certain service contracts with the State.
