(3) IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICANT HOLDING ONLY A MASTER'S DEGREE, THE APPLICANT SHALL HAVE COMPLETED A MINIMUM OF 60 GRADUATE CREDIT HOURS IN COUNSELOR TRAINING APPROVED BY THE BOARD INCLUDING INSTRUCTION IN THE AREAS SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(4) THE APPLICANT SHALL HAVE COMPLETED A MINIMUM OF 26 CREDIT HOURS IN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR TRAINING, INCLUDING INSTRUCTION IN:

(I) MEDICAL ASPECTS OF CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY;

(II) GROUP COUNSELING;

(III) INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING;

(IV) FAMILY COUNSELING;

(V) ASSESSMENT AND TREATMENT PLANNING;

(VI) ETHICS FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELORS;

(VII) HUMAN DEVELOPMENT;

(VIII) ABNORMAL PSYCHOLOGY; AND

(IX) COURSES PERTAINING TO COUNSELOR CORE FUNCTIONS OF SCREENING, INTAKE, ORIENTATION, CASE MANAGEMENT, CRISIS INTERVENTION, EDUCATION AND PREVENTION, REFERRAL, CONSULTATION,
