- (3) (i) the term of each of the two members elected from the county at large at the November 2006 election who receive the highest and second highest number of votes cast at that election shall expire after the November 2010 election, and then expire each four years thereafter; and
- (ii) the term of each of the two members elected from the county at large at the November 2006 election who receive the third and fourth highest number of votes cast at that election shall expire after the November 2008 election, and then expire each four years thereafter.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008.

## CHAPTER 530

(House Bill 1057)

AN ACT concerning

## Commercial Law - Automotive Repair Facilities - Invoices, <u>Written</u> <u>Estimates, and Forms for Authorization of Repairs</u>

FOR the purpose of requiring an invoice, a written estimate for repair work, and a form for authorization of repairs from an automotive repair facility to state that while a customer's motor vehicle is on the premises of the automotive repair facility, the automotive repair facility is not responsible for any damage to the eustomer's motor vehicle that is caused by an individual not employed by the automotive repair facility may not be responsible for damage to the customer's motor vehicle under certain circumstances, and that the customer should ask a representative of the automotive repair facility about the extent of its responsibility, including the extent of the insurance coverage of the automotive repair facility; making a stylistic change stylistic changes; and generally relating to automotive repair facilities and invoices.
