WHILE THAT EMPLOYEE IS PERFORMING MOLD REMEDIATION SERVICES ON OR WITHIN BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES OWNED OR SOLELY OCCUPIED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, THE STATE GOVERNMENT, A LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR AN INDEPENDENT AGENCY;

- (3) AN INDUSTRIAL HYGIENIST, AS DEFINED BY THE AMERICAN INDUSTRIAL HYGIENE ASSOCIATION, A PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER, OR AN ENVIRONMENTAL SANITARIAN WHO ENGAGES IN MOLD REMEDIATION SERVICES: OR
- (4) AN INDIVIDUAL REGULARLY EMPLOYED BY THE OWNER OF PROPERTY, OR THE OWNER'S AGENT, TO ENGAGE IN MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR WORK.

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE IS TO ESTABLISH A LICENSING PROGRAM FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO PERFORM OR ASSIST IN PERFORMING COMPANIES AND FIRMS THAT PROVIDE MOLD REMEDIATION SERVICES TO:

- (1) PROTECT THE PUBLIC;
- (2) IMPROVE INDOOR AIR QUALITY; AND
- (3) PROMOTE HIGH PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER POWERS <u>AND DUTIES</u> SET FORTH ELSEWHERE, THE COMMISSION SHALL:

- (1) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE;
- (2) ISSUE LICENSES;
- (3) KEEP A LIST OF ALL LICENSEES; AND
- (4) KEEP A RECORD OF ITS PROCEEDINGS.
