MINIMUM WAGE THAT IS IN EFFECT AT THE TIME OF THE ACCIDENTAL PERSONAL INJURY OR LAST INJURIOUS EXPOSURE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October July 1, 2008.

Vehicle Laws - Young Drivers - Driving Privileges <u>Learner's Instructional</u>
Permits

FOR the purpose of altering the period after which the holder of a learner's instructional permit may take certain examinations for a provisional license under certain circumstances; altering the period for which a learner's instructional permit is valid; repealing exceptions in law allowing an individual who is at least a certain age to drive on Maryland highways without obtaining a learner's instructional permit; altering the hours during which a holder of a provisional driver's license under a certain age may drive unsupervised; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to impose certain restrictions on a previsional driver's license and suspend or revoke the license under certain circumstances; altering a certain definition; modifying a certain license restriction prohibiting a holder of a provisional driver's license from driving a vehicle carrying certain passengers under certain circumstances; and generally relating to driving-privileges for young drivers learner's instructional permits.
