- (viii) the projected economic impact of immigrants in the State as it evolves in the future;
- (ix) the constraints faced by immigrants and immigrant—owned businesses in the State; and
- (x) how business and trade with immigrants' countries of origin can be expanded to benefit the State.
- (h) The Commission shall report its findings <u>and recommendations</u> to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly, on or before January 1, 2011.
- (i) To the extent possible, for each of the items of study included in this Act, the report of the Commission shall make the distinction between persons who are in lawful immigration status and those who are not in lawful immigration status.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2008. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 554

(House Bill 1607)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County – Board of Education and School Board Nominating Commission

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Legislative Services to provide staff for the School Board Nominating Commission of Anne Arundel County; repealing the provision that the increase in the salary or compensation of the President and the members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education does not apply to the incumbent President or the incumbent members of the County Board; and generally relating to the Board of Education and the School Board Nominating Commission of Anne Arundel County.
