

(ii) By utilizing the same method that it used to select the previous student member of the Board, select another student member to fill the vacancy.

(e) A Board member who does not maintain the residency qualification shall be replaced as a member.

(f) If the boundary line of a legislative district changes, an incumbent member of the County Board who, because of the change, no longer resides in the legislative district from which the member was appointed may complete the term.

(g) The President of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education is entitled to receive \$8,000 annually as compensation and, except for the student member, the other Board members are entitled to receive \$6,000 each annually as compensation.

Chapter 454 of the Acts of 2007

[SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the President and members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the President and members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
