certain public hearings, propose legislation, and conduct a public awareness campaign; providing that a member of the Council may not receive compensation as a member of the Council, but is entitled to certain reimbursement; requiring the Council to make an annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Maryland Legislative Youth Advisory Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - State Government

SUBTITLE 27. MARYLAND LEGISLATIVE YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL. 9–2701.

- (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (2) "COUNCIL" MEANS THE MARYLAND LEGISLATIVE YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL.
- (3) "HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT" MEANS A YOUTH WHO IS ENROLLED IN HIGH SCHOOL, WHO IS A HOME SCHOOL STUDENT, OR WHO IS ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM THAT LEADS TO A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE OR A GENERAL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA.
- (4) "INSTITUTION OF POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 10–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- (5) "PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 10–101 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.
- (3) (6) "Youth" means an individual who is 22 <u>years old</u> OR <u>Younger</u> 14 to 22 <u>years old</u>.
 - (B) THERE IS A MARYLAND LEGISLATIVE YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL.
