(G) (H) THE COUNCIL SHALL:

- (1) INFORM THE <u>GOVERNOR AND THE</u> GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF ISSUES CONCERNING YOUTH, INCLUDING OFFERING TESTIMONY ON THESE ISSUES BEFORE LEGISLATIVE BODIES;
 - (2) EXAMINE ISSUES OF IMPORTANCE TO YOUTH, INCLUDING:
 - (I) EDUCATION;
 - (II) A SAFE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT;
 - (III) EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES;
- (IV) STRATEGIES TO INCREASE YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL AND STATE GOVERNMENT;
 - (V) HEALTH CARE ACCESS AND QUALITY OF CARE;
 - (VI) SUBSTANCE ABUSE AND UNDERAGE DRINKING;
 - (VII) EMOTIONAL AND PHYSICAL WELL-BEING;
 - (VIII) THE ENVIRONMENT;
 - (IX) POVERTY;
 - (X) HOMELESSNESS; AND
 - (XI) YOUTH ACCESS TO STATE AND LOCAL SERVICES;
 - (XII) SUICIDE PREVENTION; AND

(XIII) EDUCATIONAL ACCESSIBILITY ISSUES FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, INCLUDING ACCESS TO:

- 1. SCHOOLS;
- 2. SCHOOL-RELATED ACTIVITIES; AND
- 3. CLASSES;
