SERVICE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAINING A COMMERCIAL ADVANTAGE, WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING PRIOR CONSENT FOR USE FROM THE SOLDIER OR THE SURVIVING SPOUSE, THE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, OR THE MAJORITY OF THE HEIRS OF THE DECEASED SOLDIER.

A PERSON THAT WHO VIOLATES § 19-402 19-403 OF THIS SECTION SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$2,500 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
