## (XIII) ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE HOSPITAL INDUSTRY.

## CHAPTER 564

(Senate Bill 154)

AN ACT concerning

## Dorchester County - Alcoholic Beverages Act of 2008

FOR the purpose of repealing the off-sale privilege of a Class B beer and light wine license in Dorchester County on and after a certain date; authorizing a holder of a Class B (on-sale and off-sale) beer and light wine license in Dorchester County that is issued on or before a certain date to continue to exercise the privileges of the license and to renew the license; prohibiting the Board of License Commissioners from approving the transfer of a certain license on or before a certain date; repealing a requirement that a holder of a certain license must purchase wine from the Dorchester County Liquor Control Board Dispensaries; clarifying that certain restaurants may obtain a certain license from the Board of License Commissioners; clarifying that a certain license provides for the consumption of beer, wine, and liquor; providing certain penalties for the violation of certain requirements regarding catering events; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to grant a special license entitling the holder to exercise certain privileges at an event conducted by a not for profit club, society, association, or organization; requiring an applicant for a
