- (1) that is organized under the laws of the United States or the State;
- (2) that is certified as a sheltered workshop by the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor;
- (3) that is accredited by the Division of Rehabilitation Services of the State Department of Education;
- (4) that is operated in the interest of individuals who have a mental or physical disability, including blindness, that:
 - (i) constitutes a substantial handicap to employment; and
- (ii) prevents the individual from engaging in normal competitive employment; and
- (5) the net income of which does not inure wholly or partly to the benefit of any shareholder or other individual.
- [(c)] (D) "State aided or controlled entity" means any public or quasi-public institution that receives aid from the State or that is owned, controlled, or managed by the State.

The State or a State aided or controlled entity shall buy supplies and services from:

- (1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises, as provided in Title 3, Subtitle 5 of the Correctional Services Article, if State Use Industries provides the supplies or services;
 - (2) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if:
- (i) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies or services; and
- (ii) Maryland Correctional Enterprises does not provide the supplies or services; ex
- (3) sheltered workshops OR INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES if:
