

(3) provide that the State procure those supplies and services from a sheltered workshop OR AN INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESS;

(4) if supplies or services are not available for procurement from a unit of the State government, determine whether supplies or services are available from a sheltered workshop OR AN INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESS;

(5) determine the fair market price of supplies and services that sheltered workshops AND INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES provide;

(6) in accordance with market conditions, adjust prices for the supplies and services that sheltered workshops AND INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES provide; and

(7) at the request of a sheltered workshop OR AN INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESS, review or change the price of a supply or service.

(F) IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES SPECIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION, THE COMMITTEE SHALL:

(1) ESTABLISH AND PERIODICALLY REVIEW ELIGIBILITY POLICIES OR GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING SHELTERED WORKSHOPS AND INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES;

(2) MAINTAIN A CURRENT LIST OF SHELTERED WORKSHOPS AND INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES; AND

(3) PERIODICALLY REVIEW AND REVISE THE LIST OF SHELTERED WORKSHOPS AND INDIVIDUAL WITH DISABILITY OWNED BUSINESSES; AND

(4) (I) SEND ANY REVISED LIST TO THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES; AND

(II) MAKE THE LIST AVAILABLE TO EACH PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR BUYING SUPPLIES OR SERVICES FOR THE STATE OR A STATE AIDED OR CONTROLLED ENTITY.
