

(ii) prevents the individual from engaging in normal competitive employment; and

(5) the net income of which does not inure wholly or partly to the benefit of any shareholder or other individual] **"COMMUNITY SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS AN ENTITY THAT:**

(1) **IS ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OR THIS STATE;**

(2) **~~IS APPROVED~~ IS ACCREDITED BY THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE EMPLOYMENT WORKS PROGRAM BY THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION SERVICES IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION;**

(3) **IS OPERATED IN THE INTEREST OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE A MENTAL OR PHYSICAL DISABILITY, INCLUDING BLINDNESS, THAT:**

(I) **CONSTITUTES A SUBSTANTIAL BARRIER TO EMPLOYMENT; AND**

(II) **PREVENTS THE INDIVIDUAL FROM ENGAGING IN COMPETITIVE EMPLOYMENT; AND**

(4) **DOES NOT INURE NET INCOME WHOLLY OR PARTLY TO THE BENEFIT OF ANY SHAREHOLDER OR OTHER INDIVIDUAL.**

(c) "State aided or controlled entity" means any public or quasi-public institution that receives aid from the State or that is owned, controlled, or managed by the State.

(A) The State or a State aided or controlled entity shall buy supplies and services from:

(1) Maryland Correctional Enterprises, as provided in Title 3, Subtitle 5 of the Correctional Services Article, if State Use Industries provides the supplies or services;

(2) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland, if:

(i) Blind Industries and Services of Maryland provides the supplies or services; and
