

AN ACT concerning

**Maryland Health Care Provider Rate Stabilization Account Funds - Transfer of Funds Transfers and Disbursements**

FOR the purpose of authorizing certain funds in a certain account of the Maryland Health Care Provider Rate Stabilization Fund to be transferred to certain accounts to be used for certain purposes; limiting a certain requirement that the Legislative Auditor conduct certain audits of a certain insurance society to years in which the society received certain disbursements from the Rate Stabilization Account of the Fund; requiring the Legislative Auditor to conduct a certain follow-up audit; authorizing the Governor, by budget amendment, to transfer a certain amount in the Cigarette Restitution Fund to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene under certain circumstances; requiring that certain revenue for a certain fiscal year be distributed to a special fund, to be used only for certain purposes; authorizing the Governor, by budget amendment, to transfer a certain amount from the special fund to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene under certain circumstances; authorizing the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to use certain funds for certain purposes; requiring the Department to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to the use of certain funds in a certain account of the Maryland Health Care Provider Rate Stabilization Fund certain transfers and disbursements of health care funds.
