laboratories of certain procedures; requiring a forensic laboratory to post the document in a certain place; providing that the dependents of certain individuals eligible for workers' compensation benefits under certain provisions of law are entitled to receive workers' compensation benefits in addition to certain retirement benefits, subject to a certain limitation; requiring the Governor to make certain appointments on or before a certain date; requiring the Washington County Commissioners to present a certain plan to the members of the General Assembly representing the county on or before a certain date; requiring the plan to establish certain goals; providing for the effect and construction of certain provisions of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally repealing and reenacting without amendments certain Acts of the General Assembly that may be subject to possible title or other defects in order to validate those Acts.
