(3) ~~If the motorcycle is equipped with a single beam lamp or lamps, the lamp or lamps shall be so aimed that, when the vehicle is loaded, none of the high intensity portion of light, at a distance of 25 feet ahead, projects higher than the level of the center of the lamp from which it comes.~~

(L) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A MOTORCYCLE MAY BE EQUIPPED WITH THE FOLLOWING AUXILIARY LIGHTING:

- (I) BLUE DOT ILLUMINATION;
- (II) STANDARD BULB RUNNING LIGHTS; OR
- (III) LIGHT-EMITTING DIODE PODS AND STRIPS ADDED TO PROTECT THE DRIVER.

(2) (I) LIGHTING UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE:

1. NONBLINKING;
2. NONFLASHING;
