- (A) A COMMUNITY ATTENDANT SERVICES AND SUPPORTS PROVIDER SHALL INFORM THE CONSUMER OF THE CONSUMER'S RIGHTS WITH RESPECT TO:
- (1) SELECTING, MANAGING, AND CHANGING THE CONSUMER'S COMMUNITY ATTENDANT SERVICES AND SUPPORTS; AND
 - (2) PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY.
- (B) A CONSUMER WHO IS DISSATISFIED WITH THE PROGRAM MAY APPEAL TO THE DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 650

(House Bill 233)

AN ACT concerning

Physicians and Pharmacists - Therapy Management Contracts - Extension of Law

FOR the purpose of extending until a certain date the termination of the provisions of law relating to certain licensed physician-pharmacist agreements and certain licensed physician-pharmacist therapy contracts; and generally relating to therapy management contracts between licensed physicians and licensed pharmacists.
