CHAPTER 686

(House Bill 1187)

AN ACT concerning

Persons Who Operate Nursing Homes - Licensure

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to be licensed by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene before operating a nursing home; establishing the qualifications for licensure: requiring the Secretary to evaluate the background and qualifications of certain persons an applicant for licensure or relicensure of a nursing home to include certain information in the application; requiring applicants to provide the Secretary with certain information; requiring the Secretary to issue licenses to applicants who meet certain requirements; authorizing licensees to renew licensees under certain circumstances authorizing the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to make certain approvals or denials of licensure applications after a certain review; requiring licensees to report to the Secretary certain changes in the financial condition of a nursing home; authorizing the Secretary to verify certain financial conditions requiring the Secretary to convene a certain workgroup to make certain recommendations; requiring the Secretary to review certain recommendations and to publish certain regulations on or before a certain date; making certain exceptions; requiring the Secretary to adopt certain regulations; defining certain-terms; and generally relating to the licensure of persons who operate nursing homes.
