- (iii) Within 150 feet in Anne Arundel County, CALVERT, St. Mary's County, or Kent County downriver from Nichols Point at the eastern side of the mouth of Langford Creek and within 300 feet upriver from Nichols Point;
- (6) The Dorchester County waters of the Choptank River and its tributaries except as provided in §§ 4–1038(a) and 4–1039 of this subtitle; Brannock Bay; Little Choptank River; Tar Bay; Honga River; all waters east of a line running from the most southerly point of Holland Island to Holland Island Bar Light; all waters east of a line running from Richland Point to Okahanikan Point; and any areas reserved by the Department for production of seed oysters; and
 - (7) In the Atlantic Coastal Bays, as defined in § 8-1802 of this article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008, the effective date of Chapter 260 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2007. If the effective date of Chapter 260 is amended, this Act shall take effect on the taking effect of Chapter 260.

CHAPTER 699

(House Bill 1537)

AN ACT concerning

Real Property Assessments - Assessment Notice - Requirements

FOR the purpose of altering the circumstances under which a failure to send certain assessment notices within a certain time creates a certain irrebuttable presumption under certain circumstances; and generally relating to assessment notices sent by the State Department of Assessments and Taxation.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
