FOR the purpose of exempting from the prohibition against an employer requiring or demanding, as a condition of employment, prespective employment, or continued employment, that an individual submit to or take a lie detector or similar test, individuals who apply for employment or are employed as correctional officers for with the Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities either as correctional officers or in any other capacity that involves direct personal contact with an inmate in the Department; and generally relating to the Anne Arundel County Department of Detention Facilities.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Labor and Employment

3 - 702.

- (a) In this section, "employer" means:
- (1) a person engaged in a business, industry, profession, trade, or other enterprise in the State;
  - (2) the State;
  - (3) a county; and
  - (4) a municipal corporation in the State.
- (b) (1) This section does not apply to the federal government or any of its units.
