

(e) If a bottled water product is not in compliance with any requirement under subsection (c) or (d) of this section:

(1) The Department shall revoke the waiver; and

(2) The product shall be subject to the filtration and disinfection treatment requirements under subsection (a) of this section.

(f) Except for filtration and disinfection treatment, this section may not be construed to waive any requirement that is applicable under this subtitle to a bottled water product.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

## CHAPTER 54

(House Bill 219)

AN ACT concerning

### Bedding Law - Repeal

FOR the purpose of repealing the bedding law in the State.

BY repealing

Article - Health - General

Section 24-401 through 24-435 and the subtitle "Subtitle 4. Bedding"

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2005 Replacement Volume and 2007 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 24-401 through 24-435 and the subtitle "Subtitle 4. Bedding" of Article - Health - General of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
