Chapter 347 of the Acts of 2005

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before September 1, 2008, the Maryland Insurance Administration and the Maryland Health Insurance Plan shall submit a report, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee on:

(a) the effect of excluding self-employed individuals and sole proprietors from the small group market on the availability and affordability of health insurance in the small group market; and

(b) the number of self-employed individuals and sole proprietors enrolled in the Maryland Health Insurance Plan.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of [3] 6 years and, at the end of September 30, [2008] 2011, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 77

(House Bill 467)

AN ACT concerning

Calvert County – Public Facilities Bonds

FOR the purpose of authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of Calvert County, from time to time, to borrow not more than \$8,895,000 to finance the construction, improvement, or development of certain public facilities in Calvert County, as herein defined, and to effect such borrowing by
