

Chart be approved by the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County; requiring the Planning and Zoning Officer to prepare the Chart; providing for approval of the Chart by ordinance of the County Council; providing that a School Utilization Chart remains in effect until replaced or revised; repealing a certain termination provision established by a 2003 ordinance in Bill No. 43-03 relating to the maximum period of time an applicant for subdivision or development is required to remain on the waiting list because of the inadequacy of public school facilities; approving a School Utilization Chart prepared by the Planning and Zoning Officer; providing for the effective date of the School Utilization Chart adopted by this Ordinance; making this ordinance an emergency ordinance; and generally relating to adequate public school facilities in Anne Arundel County.

AN ACT concerning

### Fire Hydrants – Use Regulations and Enforcement

FOR the purpose of clarifying that the Department of Public Works may adopt regulations regarding the use of fire hydrants; specifying, without limitations, topics that may be included in the regulations; providing for a violating of the fire hydrant law or regulations; authorizing the Department of Public Works and the Code Official to enforce the fire hydrant law and regulations; and generally relating to the county's fire hydrant policy.
