## Bill No. 07-50

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection A, of Section 9–28, Membership; terms, of Article VI, Mental Health and Addictions Advisory Council, of Part 2, Nonbinding Advisory Boards, of Chapter 9, Boards, Commissions, Councils and Agencies; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Article XXVIIC, Core Service Agency, of Part 3, Authoritative Boards and Commissions, of Chapter 9, Boards, Commissions, Councils and Agencies; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection B(8), of Section 23–12, Persons required to file statements, of Article IV, Financial Disclosure, of Chapter 23, Ethics Code, all of the Harford County Code, as amended; to change the name of the Harford County Core Service Agency to the Office on Mental Health Core Service Agency, Inc.

## Bill No. 07-52

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Subsection A(5) of Section 23–10, Exemptions, of Article III, Conflicts of Interest; and to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Subsection A(5) of Section 23–14, Contents of statement, of Article IV, Financial Disclosure, all of Chapter 23, Ethics Code, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide for clarification of the law on receipt and financial disclosure of gifts by elected officials in Harford County and by persons who receive gifts from any person who does business with the County, is regulated by the County; or is a lobbyist registered under County law.

## Bill No. 07-53, As Amended

AN ACT to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 123-44, Credit for solar energy units, of Article II, Real Property Tax Credits, of Chapter 123, Finance and Taxation, of the Harford County Code, as amended; to provide a property tax credit for additional qualifying energy conservation devices; to add new definitions for solar energy device and geothermal energy device; to increase the property tax credit for all qualifying energy conservation devices from \$1,000 to \$2,500; to provide for the effective date of the credit; and generally relating to real property tax credits for qualifying energy conservation devices.
