**CHARTER RESOLUTION**

OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK, MARYLAND, AMENDING ARTICLE IX, "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES", § C9-1 "DISCRIMINATION" TO CLARIFY THAT EMPLOYEES MAY RETAIN THEIR POSITIONS WHILE RUNNING FOR OFFICE OR SERVING AS ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICIALS OF JURISDICTIONS OTHER THAN THE CITY, UNLESS, SUCH OFFICE WOULD PRESENT A REAL OR POTENTIAL CONFLICT OF INTEREST OR THE APPEARANCE OF A CONFLICT OF INTEREST.
