

Article 16 – Public Local Laws of Maryland
(2004 Edition and December 2007 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 16 – Montgomery County

70-5.

The Oakmont Citizens' Committee [shall] MAY not expend for material or work a sum exceeding [two] TEN thousand dollars [(\$2,000.00)] **(\$10,000)** without having first advertised the specifications [therefor] and inviting bids for the same, after which the committee may purchase such material [or may], contract for [such] THE work, or have [such] THE work done by employed labor, or otherwise as it may deem best[; and provided further, that the committee may make contracts, and provided further, that no member of the citizens' committee shall]. **PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE CITIZENS' COMMITTEE MAY, BY UNANIMOUS VOTE, ENTER INTO A CONTRACT EXCEEDING \$10,000 WITHOUT SEEKING COMPETITIVE BIDS IF THE CONTRACT IS NECESSARY TO MEET AN URGENT NEED. NO MEMBER OF THE CITIZENS' COMMITTEE MAY** furnish any supplies of any kind or contract in any manner with the citizens' committee.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.
