- (I) ANY FOOD PRODUCT NOT HAVING AFFIXED TO THE FOOD PRODUCT THE ORIGINAL SLAUGHTERHOUSE PLUMBA OR ANY OTHER MARK, STAMP, TAG, BRAND, LABEL, OR OTHER MEANS OF IDENTIFICATION EMPLOYED TO INDICATE THAT THE FOOD PRODUCT IS HALAL; OR
- (II) ANY FOOD PRODUCT TO WHICH THE SLAUGHTERHOUSE PLUMBA, MARK, STAMP, TAG, BRAND, LABEL, OR OTHER MEANS OF IDENTIFICATION HAS BEEN FRAUDULENTLY AFFIXED.

A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE IS:

- (1) AN UNFAIR OR DECEPTIVE TRADE PRACTICE WITHIN THE MEANING OF TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (2) SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY PROVISIONS CONTAINED IN TITLE 13 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 113

(House Bill 1085)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Regulation of Special Events

FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons, corporations, partnerships, associations, and entities from holding certain events without first obtaining a certain special event permit; authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County to adopt certain regulations by ordinance or resolution concerning certain special event permit applications, processes, fees, penalties, appeal procedures, and exceptions; exempting certain events from the provisions of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to special events in Washington County.
