

(2) UNLESS IT IS AN EVENT REQUIRING ASSISTANCE, AN ATHLETIC EVENT HELD ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AS PART OF THE REGULAR ACTIVITY OF AN ATHLETIC OR RECREATIONAL SPORTS LEAGUE THAT HAS RECEIVED PERMISSION TO USE PUBLIC FACILITIES FROM THE WASHINGTON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION; AND

(3) AN ATHLETIC EVENT OR ENTERTAINMENT EVENT SPONSORED AND DIRECTED IN WHOLE BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2008.

CHAPTER 114

(House Bill 1156)

AN ACT concerning

Labor and Employment – Pay Disparity Data – Reporting

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to collect certain employee data; authorizing the Commissioner to analyze certain records to study pay disparity issues; requiring the Commissioner to provide a certain report to the General Assembly; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the reporting of pay disparity data.
