- C. IN THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS CRITICAL AREA, ANY LEGAL PARCEL OF LAND, NOT BEING PART OF A RECORDED OR APPROVED SUBDIVISION, THAT WAS RECORDED AS OF JUNE 1, 2002; AND
- D. IN THE ATLANTIC COASTAL BAYS CRITICAL AREA, LAND THAT WAS SUBDIVIDED INTO RECORDED LEGALLY BUILDABLE LOTS, WHERE THE SUBDIVISION RECEIVED THE LOCAL JURISDICTION'S FINAL APPROVAL BEFORE JUNE 1, 2002;
- [(xiii)] 14. 13. Except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, provisions for granting a variance to the local jurisdiction's critical area program, in accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission concerning variances set forth in COMAR 27.01.11; [and]
- [(xiv)] 15. 14. Penalty provisions establishing that, in addition to any other penalty applicable under State or local law, 2 EACH person who violates a provision of this subtitle or of a program, INCLUDING A CONTRACTOR, PROPERTY OWNER, OR ANY OTHER PERSON WHO COMMITTED, ASSISTED, AUTHORIZED, OR PARTICIPATED IN A THE VIOLATION:
 - A. [is] IS subject to a fine not exceeding \$10,000; AND
