COST-SHARE AGREEMENTS, OR OTHER ACTION SIMILAR ACTIONS PROPOSED BY A GRANT APPLICATION.

- 4 THE BAYSTAT SUBCABINET AGENCIES MAY DISTRIBUTE TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE COST ACCOUNT THE AMOUNT THAT IS NECESSARY TO ADMINISTER GRANT PROGRAMS, NOT TO EXCEED 1.5% OF THE ALLOCATIONS TO THE BAYSTAT SUBCABINET AGENCIES.
- (D) ANY GRANT AGREEMENT REGARDING FUNDS FROM THE TRUST FUND SHALL:
- (1) SPECIFY THE USE OF THE FUNDS PROVIDED UNDER THE GRANT, ACCOUNTABILITY MEASURES, AND PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS; AND
- (2) Take into account the need for efficient, multiyear multi-year funding and administration; and
- (3) INCLUDE PROVISIONS FOR VERIFICATION THAT PRACTICES ARE BEING IMPLEMENTED.
- (E) (1) A RECIPIENT OF A FUNDS FROM THE TRUST FUND GRANT IN ANY FISCAL YEAR SHALL SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE BAYSTAT PROGRAM BY NOVEMBER 1 OF THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR.
- (2) THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:
- (I) AN ESTIMATE OF THE NUTRIENT LOADING-REDUCTIONS
 RESULTING-FROM AN ONGOING PROJECT, AND THE TIME FRAME FOR
 COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT; AND
- (II) AN ASSESSMENT OF NUTRIENT LOADING REDUCTIONS AND WATER QUALITY BENEFITS ACHIEVED THROUGH COMPLETED PROJECTS.
- (I) FOR AGENCIES RECEIVING MONEYS FROM THE TRUST FUND:
- 1. A DESCRIPTION OF HOW THE FUNDS WERE ALLOCATED, INCLUDING:
 - A. THE NUMBER AND AMOUNTS OF GRANTS AWARDS;
