Anderson

Thomas Brown aged about twenty one years five feet seven inches high of dark complexion has a mark on the right thumb produced by a wart was born free Certificate issued on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1854 upon the affidavit of Thomas S. Plummer.

Maria Smallwood aged about thirty one ~~and~~ five feet four inches high, of Copper complexion has no visible scars, was manumitted by the late William Bateman, by deed of manumission of record in Anne Arundel County Court in Liber B. N. 2. folio 105. & 106. one of the Manumission record books of Anne Arundel County. Certificate issued on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of January 1855. upon the affidavit of Dr. Jonathan Waters.

Joshua Johnson aged about twenty six years five feet seven inches high, of Copper complexion has a scar on the cheek caused by the bite of a Dog was born free. Certificate issued on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of February 1855. upon the affidavit of George Bond.

Branson Johnson aged about twenty three years, five feet six and a half inches high, of Brown complexion has a scar over the upper lip from the bite of a Dog was born free. Certificate issued Feb<sup>y</sup> 6<sup>th</sup> 1855. upon the affidavit of George Bond.

Robert Ridgely aged about thirty eight years, five feet nine and a half inches high, of dark complexion, has a mark on the right wrist caused by a burn, was manumitted by William Lee by deed of manumission dated the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord 1844. and recorded among the Chatter Records in Liber W. H. N. N. 3 folio 374e. Certificate issued on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February 1855. upon the affidavit of George R. Saiters.

Richard Matthews, aged about thirty five years, six feet high, of dark complexion, a scar on the right wrist & one finger contracted, was manumitted by the will of Ric<sup>d</sup>. J. S. Worthington. Certificate issued Feb<sup>y</sup> 20<sup>th</sup> 1855. upon the personal knowledge of W<sup>m</sup>. H. Worthington.

John S. Hall, aged about twenty seven years, five feet seven inches high of Brown complexion, has a scar on
