Caused by a burn also a prominent Scar on his right shin bone Cause by falling upon a rock. Was born free Certificate issued upon the representation and affidavit of Thomas H. Hunt December 22<sup>nd</sup> 1857.

Thomas Courtley aged about Twenty nine years five feet five inches of dark Complexion has a Scar on the left cheek. Manumitted by deed of manumission from Joel Blew, dated January the first Eighteen hundred and fifty eight & recorded among the chattel records of Howard County in Liber 71, 76 N. No 3 folio 273. Certificate issued upon the representation & affidavit of Wm M Isaac, January 14<sup>th</sup> 1858.
