

Kitty Hawkins aged about twenty five years, five feet two and a half inches high of mulatto complexion, has no visible marks, was manumitted by Bill of Sale from Anna M. Hopkins to Nelson M. Peck dated August 2nd 1847 & recorded among the Chattel Records of Howard County in Liber E. T. No. 1: 2 folio 25^{re}. Certificate issued January 21st 1858 upon the representation & affidavit of Dr Littleton Maclin.

James Snowden, aged about twenty two year, five feet. Two and a half inches high of copper complexion has a black mole on each shoulder and a split in the left thumb nail was born free. Certificate issued upon the representation ^{or affidavit} of Dr. Littleton Maclin February 2nd 1858.

Mary Brian aged about thirty five year, four feet eleven inches high of dark complexion has a scar on the right hand & also on end of second finger, on same hand. Caused by bone fellow became free under Bill of Sale, from Philemon Warfield to Thomas Bartholow Certificate issued March 11th 1858 upon the representation & affidavit of Gustavus Warfield

Singleton Woodward aged about twenty two years five feet four and three quarters inches high of dark complexion has a scar on the left hand produced by a cut from an axe. Was born free. Certificate issued upon the representation & affidavit of John J. Hood Esq. March 15th 1858.

Elizabeth Dorsey, now Bradford, aged about twenty two years, five feet three inches high light complexion has no visible scars, was born free. Certificate issued upon the representation and affidavit of John W. Gaither May 4th 1858. (papers delivered Sept. 25/58)

Ann Maria Dorsey, now France, aged about twenty years, four feet eleven and a half inches high light complexion has no visible scars, was born free. Certificate issued upon the representation and affidavit of John W. Gaither May 4th 1858. (papers delivered Sept. 25 1858)

Martha Jason, aged about forty years, five feet four and a half inches high dark mulatto complexion has a scar on the left arm near the elbow. Caused by a burn. Manumitted by deed of manumission from Abolonia Warfield dated eighteenth day of April 1858, and recorded among the Chattel Records of Howard County in Liber N. 76 N. No 3 folio 91^{re}. Certificate issued upon the representation and affidavit of Reuben Warfield, May 4th 1858. Parliament made out.
