 years and them the said Negroes named Re-  
 becca, Misky and Isaac Thomas, I do declare  
 to be henceforth free Manumitted and dis-  
 charged from all manner of servitude or ser-  
 vice to me my executors, administrators  
 forever, In testimony whereof I have here-  
 unto set my hand and affixed my seal this  
 27<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord 1822.
