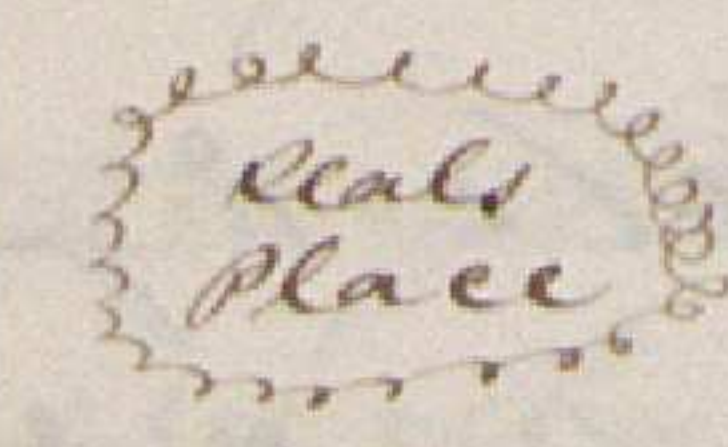

 Decd of Manumission } it known, that I, Sarah b. War-
 do } field, of Howard County, in the
 Eliza Prettyman } State of Maryland, for divers good
 } Causes and Considerations, me
 thereto moving, have released from slavery,
 liberated and set free, and by these presents do
 hereby release from slavery, liberate, manumit
 and set free, my mulatto woman, named Eliza
 Prettyman, now aged twenty eight years, and
 able to work and maintain herself, and her
 the said mulatto woman named Eliza Pretty-
 man, I do hereby declare to be henceforth free,
 manumitted, and discharged from all man-
 ner of service or servitude to me, my execu-
 tors or administrators, forever, In witness
 whereof, I hereto set my hand and seal, this
 seventeenth day of August, Eighteen hun-
 dred and fifty five,
