 erty, Now this Indenture witnesseth
 that the said Wesley Linthicum, Seth
 W. Warfield, Thomas J. White, Samuel R.
 Powell and Christian A. Dorsey for and
 in consideration of the above men-
 tioned premises and for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of one dollar
 in hand paid by the said William
 H. Worthington the receipt whereof
 the said parties of the first part
 doth acknowledge themselves to be
 fully satisfied contented and paid,
 hath and by these presents, doth
 give, grant, bargain, sell and re-
 lease enfeof and confirm unto him
 the said William H. Worthington and
 his heirs and assigns forever all the
 above and aforesaid personal
 property, I do give and I do hold the
 same to him the said William H.
 Worthington his heirs and assigns for-
 ever, to his and their only proper use
 and behoof and to and for no other use
 intent or purpose whatsoever,

 J. White, Samuel R. Powell and
 Christian A. Dorsey hath hereunto set
 their hands and affixed their seals
