Now the Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Littleton Maclin shall faithfully execute his office as Treasurer of Howard County and well and truly account for and pay over to the Treasurer of Maryland the several sums of money, which he shall receive or be answerable for at such times as the law directs, then this obligation
