Hare doth expressly covenant and agree with the said Michael Williamson that he will teach and instruct the said apprentice in the business of a farmer and that he will well and faithfully find for the said apprentice good and sufficient cloathing meat lodging and other necessaries fit and proper for such an apprentice during the term aforesaid and further annually pay to the said Michael Williamson the sum of twenty dollars after deducting therefrom Doctors Bills or any expense to which he may be put by the misconduct of the said apprentice provided that the last payment shall be made to the said Michael for the use of the said apprentice at his majority.
