Hoyle, his executors, administrators, and assigns forever, and the said Leander Waters for my self my heirs, executors, and administrators, all and singular the said goods, and chattles, and other the premises into the said George W. Hoyle his executors administrators and assigns, against me the said Leander Waters, my executors and administrators and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents, of all and singular which said goods & chattles and other the premises, & the said Leander Waters, have put the said Geo. W. Hoyle in full possession by delivering to him the said Geo. W. Hoyle one black horse at the sealing and delivering of these presents in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended to be so unto him the said Geo. W. Hoyle as aforesaid, In witness whereof I the said Leander Waters have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this thirtzeth day of November eighteen hundred and fifty five,
