


 intent and meaning of these presents, and of
 the said parties hereto, that if the said
 Levi Chambers or Julia A. Chambers, or their
 executors or administrators, do and shall
 well and truly pay and satisfy unto Abram
 England, the said Judgment, with inter-
 est and costs thereon, as herein before
 set forth, on or before the 23rd day of Feb-
 ruary 1857, then and from thenceforth
 these presents, and every matter and
 thing therein contained shall cease and
 be utterly null and void, any thing
 herein to the contrary thereof in any
 wise notwithstanding, In witness whereof,
